***Identity Crisis* Documentary Produced by Charlie Kirk Headlines Detrans Hollywood Film Series Challenging Industry Blackout**

Los Angeles, CA. **Detrans Hollywood** launches this October 14th—the National Day of Remembrance for Charlie Kirk—with a **series of film events** that demand Hollywood stop ignoring detransitioners and their stories. The events are **free to attend**, ensuring open access to the public, while also serving as a **donation-based fundraising campaign** to support the development of a narrative feature film about the life of detrans activist Chloe Cole.

The series is **co-sponsored by 180 Shift**, a Gen Z-focused social media channel and podcast dedicated to amplifying voices silenced by legacy media.

*“The industry pushes trans stories—even in kids' shows—but when I sought advice from a studio exec on the *Chloe Cole Movie*, she said no major player would touch it. Even at a Christian film festival, a panelist quipped that Jesus would return before I got this movie made. This is why *Detrans Hollywood* matters: we can't just cancel Netflix. We must produce movies about detrans stories of healing, hope, and redemption.”*

Headline Film: *Identity Crisis*

The capstone of the series, ***Identity Crisis***, is the **only feature-length film ever executive produced by Charlie Kirk**—and the very topic he was addressing when he was brutally murdered. Produced by Turning Point USA and distributed by The Daily Wire, the film examines the devastating impact of gender ideology on young people, parents, families and society.

The screening will be hosted in Pasadena by Republican gubernatorial candidate, Pastor Ché Ahn, and Harvest Rock Church on **November 9 at the Ambassador Auditorium** and includes:

- **Red carpet arrivals and interviews with 180 Shift**
- **Panel discussion** with the film's director, Marcus Wada, detransitioners Chloe Cole and Laura Becker, and parents' rights advocates Adam Vena and Harrison Tinsley (also performing his Charlie Kirk tribute song, *Remember Your Name*)
- **Invitations extended** to 2026 California gubernatorial candidates

Spotlight: *Cedar Road* Music Video

Alongside the documentaries, screenings will feature *Cedar Road* —a music video showcasing Isaac Martinez's soulful coming-of-age anthem and detransitioner Chloe Cole's bold acting debut. The video premiered earlier this year at the Turning Point USA Young Women's Leadership Summit.

Documentary Lineup

Detrans Hollywood will also showcase the additional documentaries:

- **Oct 14—*The Lost Boys***. Follows five young men and their journeys with gender dysphoria—rooted in feelings of inadequacy and influences like pornography. Also showing: IWFeatures profile of **Luke Healy** and his mother’s refusal to affirm his transition
- **Oct 17—*Art Club***. Colorado Mom Erin Lee’s story of her fight to save her daughter from an LGBTQ grooming after-school program
- **Oct 20—*No Way Back***. Canceled by AMC Theatres after activist threats, this film became a flashpoint in the debate over free speech and gender ideology
- **Oct 23—*The War on Children***. Banned by Amazon on its initial release—Robby Starbuck’s exposé of the radical ideologies indoctrinating young minds
- **Oct 27—*Trans Kids: It’s Time to Talk***. Channel 4 documentary by Genspect’s Stella O’Malley that considers the sharp rise in gender transition in young people. Also showing: Genspect’s animated series ***Detransitioners Unheard***
- **Oct 29—*Damaged: The Transing of America’s Kids***. Daily Caller’s account of people who transitioned in youth and later regretted it, including Chloe Cole. Also showing: PragerU’s short doc ***Detrans: The Dangers of Gender-Affirming Care***
- **Nov 3—*Detransition Diaries & Trans Mission: What’s the Rush to Reassign Gender?*** Double feature from the Center for Bioethics and Culture Network exploring medicalization for minors, ethical questions, and the harmful cost of irreversible “gender-affirming” treatments
- **Nov 6—*Dysconnected***. Exploring the rise in young girls identifying as transgender

Film showings will be hosted at Def Noodles Club (Hollywood), Calvary Baptist Church (Burbank), and Saint Andrew Catholic Church (Pasadena). Admission to all events is **free of charge**, but the series doubles as a **donation-driven fundraiser**. Proceeds will go toward developing the Chloe Cole feature, including production of a proof-of-concept short film (script available upon request).
